This discipline will be taught in English. It aims to build understanding of China among Brazilian & foreign students. At the BRICS Network University, we learnt aspects of how more than 40% of humanity functions sociologically. Examined challenges, conflicts, understanding etc. and introduced sociological perspectives on: culture, consumption, youth, environment, sport, stratification etc. This discipline has 3 sections: 1) Introductory contextualizing lectures 2) Online real-time lectures by Chinese scholars, debated in real time by Brazilian researchers. 3) Student seminars Beijing-Campinas.

Ementa em Português:

Esta disciplina será ministrada em inglês. O objetivo é construir a compreensão da China entre estudantes brasileiros e estrangeiros. Na BRICS Network University, aprendemos aspectos de como mais de 40% da humanidade funciona sociologicamente. Examinou desafios, conflitos, compreensão etc. e introduziu perspectivas sociológicas sobre: cultura, consumo, juventude, meio ambiente, esporte, estratificação etc. Esta disciplina tem 3 seções: 1) Aulas introdutórias de contextualização 2) Palestras online em tempo real por estudiosos chineses, debatidas em tempo real por pesquisadores brasileiros. 3) Seminários de estudantes em Pequim e Campinas.
